THE GOAL OF CREATING ELECTRONIC DATABASE

- I. Assist targeted directorates in:
 - Developing and planning of phases
 - Optimal use of available resources
 - Making decisions based on results and statistics
 - Monitoring achievement of plans goals
- 2. Unify the methodology of development and implementation of plans of targeted directorates.

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE ELECTRONIC DATABASE

- It includes all data related to development, implementation and monitoring
- 2. It is easy to use
- 3. It reduces time, efforts and cost
- 4. Easy to continuously update and obtain new results
- 5. It is not costly to implement
- 6. It can be developed by staff according to future needs of the Directorate

REQUIREMENTS FOR CREATION OF A DATABASE IN EACH TARGETED DIRECTORATE

- I. Two employees specialized in Information Technology (IT)
- 2. Current need of equipment:
 - Personal computer in the IT Section to manage the database
 - Personal computer and a printer for the Planning Team Chair to use it for updating and following-up
 - Personal computer to Directors to review and follow-up results
 - Connect the three computers with a local network

REQUIREMENTS FOR CREATION OF A DATABASE IN EACH TARGETED DIRECTORATE

- 3. The need of equipment for the first expansion: a personal computer is needed in concerned sections of the directorate headquarter to be used for continuous update and monitoring implementation of results; a central printer is also needed in the IT section.
- 4. The need of equipment for the second expansion: a personal computer is needed in the field to be used for continuous update and monitoring; the computer is to be connected online with the directorate

- I Develop standards for service
- 2- Calculate indicators and gaps based on data and equations
- 3- Analyze gaps
- 4- Develop proposed short-term and long-term solutions

- 5- Conduct SWOT (Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, and Threats)
 Analysis
- 6- Develop goals using SMART tool
- 7- Write the full strategic plan

- 8. Submit the Plan to the provincial Task Force for approval
- 9. Develop an action plan for implementation of the short-term solutions using available resources
- 10. Submit the long-term solutions within the investment budget to the Provincial Council for approval

- II. Conduct the necessary update on the completed plan based on the approval of the Provincial Council, Ministry of Planning and Ministry of Finance
- 12. Develop an action plan for the implementation of the long-term solutions
 - Use of available resources
