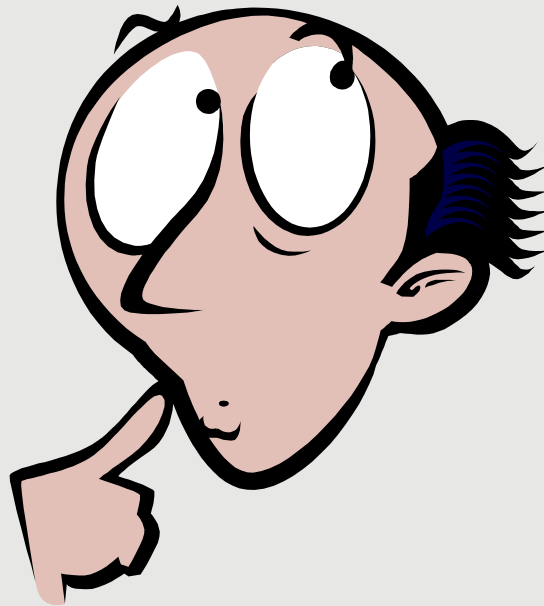

## GENERAL GUIDELINE

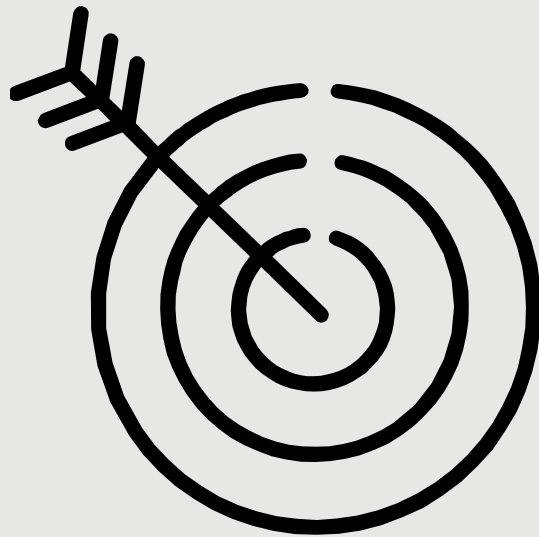
- How will we work during the upcoming nine days?
