- Does not require legislation


#### SERVICE DIRECTORATES ARE ABLE TO:

# OBJECTIVES OF MONITORING AND OVERSIGHT OF DELIVERY OF SERVICES DIVISION

- I.Common monitoring over services in the governorate
- 2. Develop monitoring and periodic reporting mechanism to activate the monitoring and oversight role on services
- 3. strengthen mutual coordination between the monitoring and the executive authorities
- 4. Activate the role of local councils and civil society organizations to monitor and oversight the delivery of services
- 5. Assess and develop proposals to assess the performance of service departments to advance the reality of services delivered to citizens
- 6. Common planning work for future service projects

### PROVINCIAL DEVELOPMENT AND PLANNING COUNCIL BYLAW ARTICLE 8

- I. Develop Medium and long-term vision for the sustainable development pathways in the province
- 2. Define the various aspects of the development priorities in the province
- 3. Define the roles and responsibilities of the Central and provincial local government departments
- 4. Discuss the action programs of the Federal Ministries, local departments and coordinating those programs

## PROVINCIAL DEVELOPMENT AND PLANNING COUNCIL BYLAW ARTICLE 8

- 5. Discuss the provincial investment budget and recommend the provincial Council to approve them.
- 6. Follow up the implementation of the provincial ongoing investment budget in the province.
- 7. Evaluating the performance of the Central and the provincial local administrations and to propose remedies, thereof.
- 8. Facilitate cooperation between public and private sectors and civil society to identify common goals and realistic solutions.
- 9. Coordinating the development effort between Maysan province and neighborhood provinces to ensure regional integration and optimal investment of the provincial comparative advantages.
