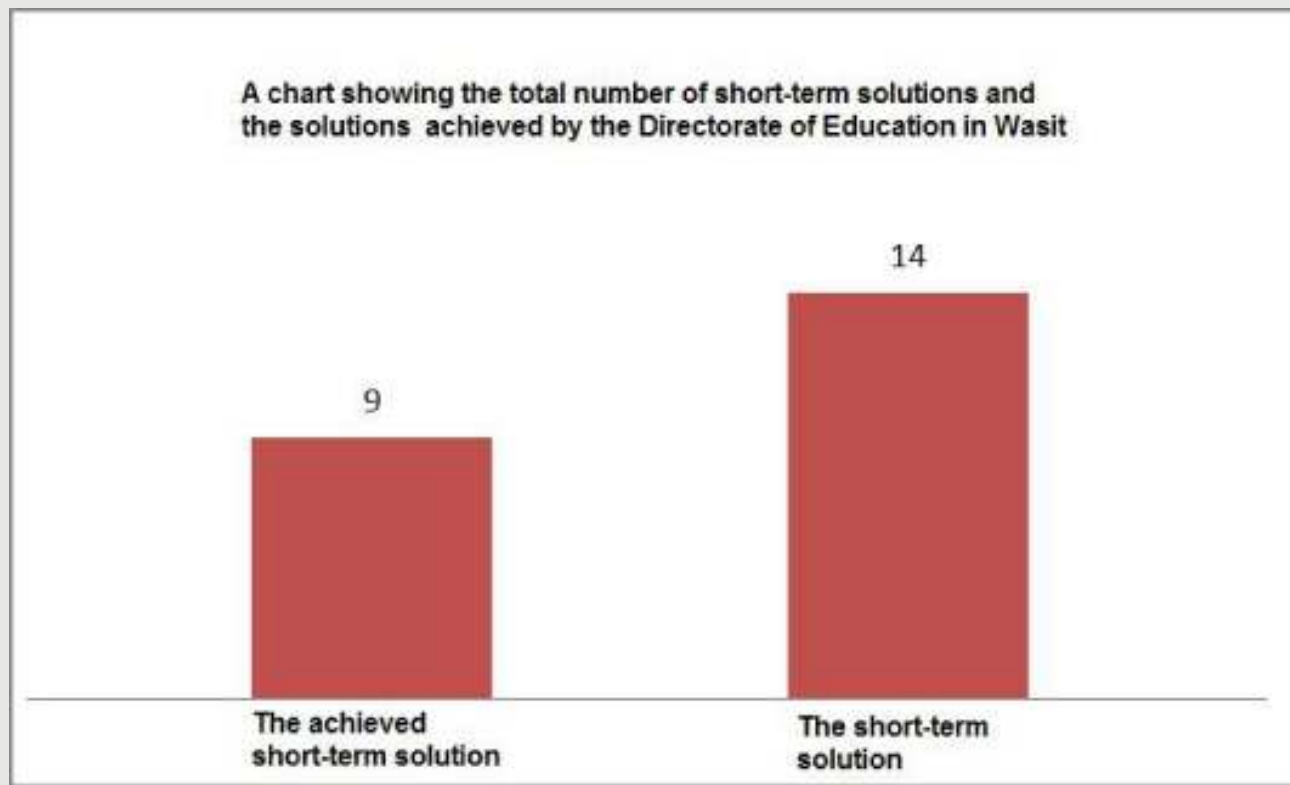

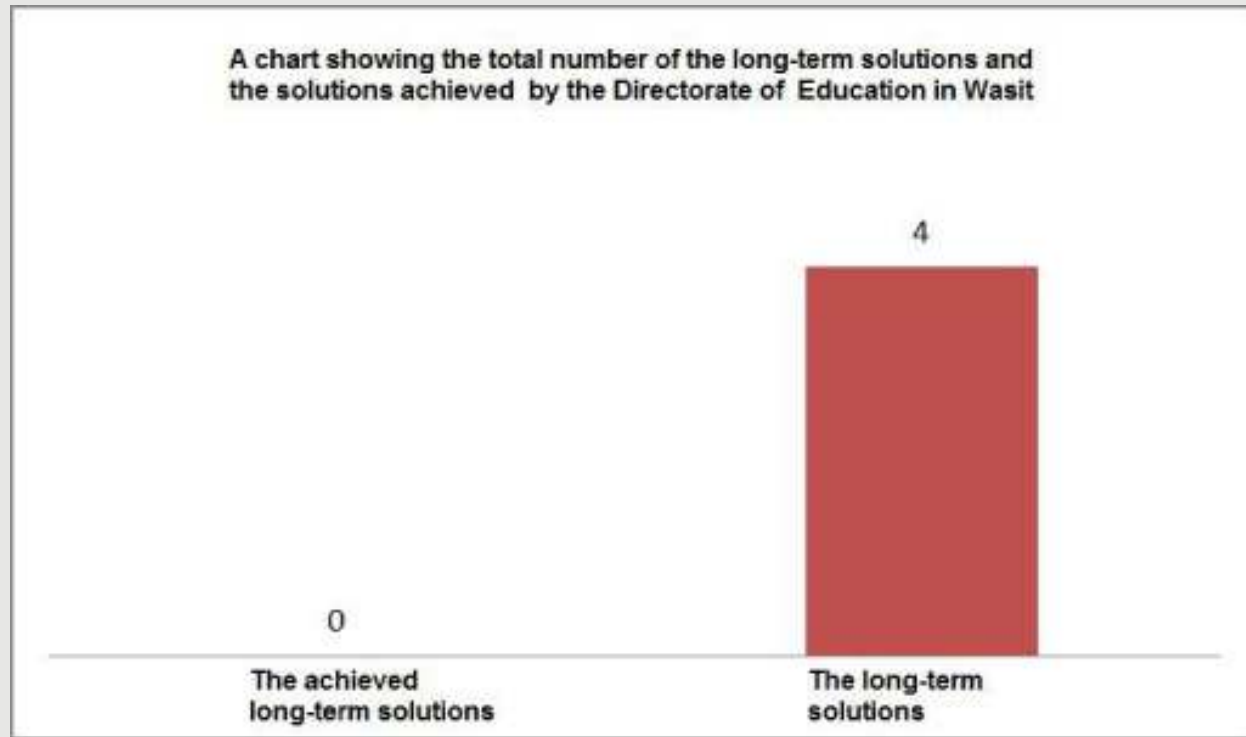

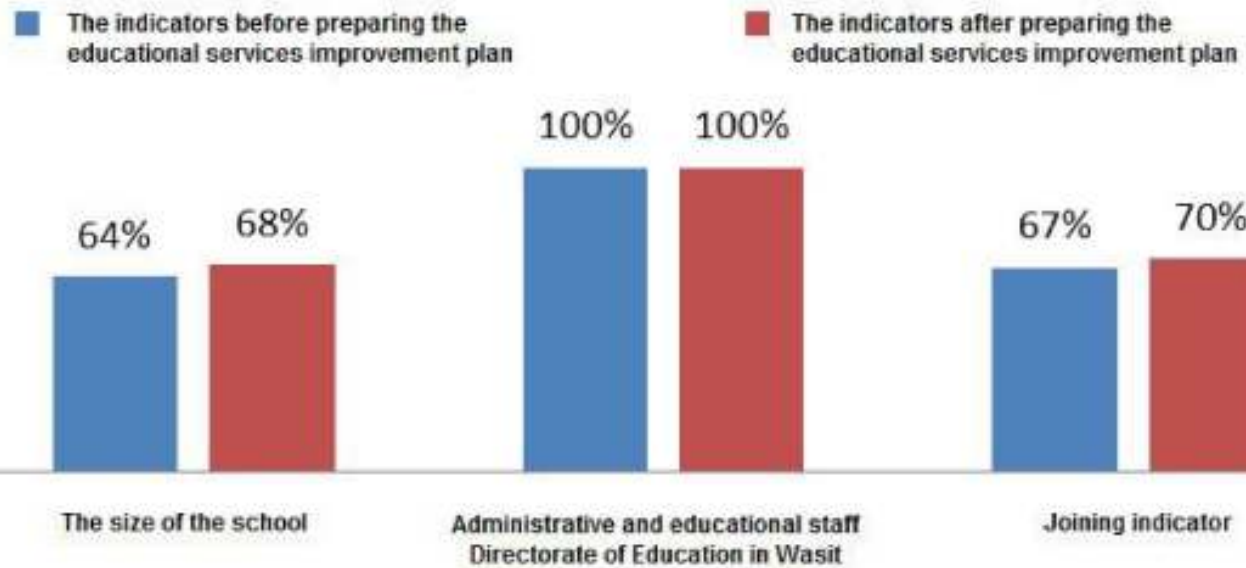

Focus was made on following points (standard) during the field visits:

- 2- Education Management and staff
- 3- The educational environment.
- 4- Efficiency of the educational system

MOST IMPORTANT CONCLUSIONS FROM THE FIELD VISITS

In these visits and depending on the standards above, we found:

School roofs are in need to maintenance and mastic works for there are obvious cracks leading to water leakage

Toilets are in a bad condition

Water taps

The number of students in one class

The number of students in the school is 750 and the school needs additional halls

The quality and the quantity of stationery are below the required
